

Subscription Rates

Family Senior Membership £160, Senior Membership £144, Family Social Membership £160, Social Membership £144, Associate Membership £54, Senior Social £43, Crew £33.

The Committee may, at their discretion, increase the subscriptions in line Rule 9(a).

Members are bound by the Club Rules and the Byelaws as adopted from time to time. Applicants may ask for a copy of these prior to completion of this form. Contact details are on the front cover of this form.

Extracts from the Club Rules:

Rule 9. (b)

Family Membership (1) and Family Social Membership (3) subscription includes for the elected Member, their partner and members of their family under the age of 18 years or 25 years whilst remaining in full time education. The full name of the partner shall be included in the official Membership list which is open to scrutiny by all Members. Any partner not so named will be subject to rules applying to visitors. Family Membership grades are designed for married couples with or without children. In the context of such Membership the description of partner will be strictly interpreted to mean husband and wife, whether legally married or established cohabiting adults. (e.g. common law husband and wife).

Rule 9. (c)

Senior Membership (2) and Social Membership (4) covers individuals. A partner not being a Member in their own right would be classified as a visitor. Attention is drawn to the Bye-law No.3 restricting the number of visits permitted during anyone year.

Rule 9. (d)

An Associate Member (5) shall be one who is a Member of at least 3 years standing of a recognised Yacht Club and who does not moor their yacht on Club waters, i.e. downstream from Lincombe lock to upstream of Tewkesbury lock. At the time of application for Membership and each subsequent year a current Membership Card of the parent club must be produced.

A Family member or Senior Social Member of the Severn Motor Yacht Club of at least 3 years standing may apply for Associate Membership if, having moved away from the area, he no longer moors his boat on Club waters, and has joined another recognised yacht club or Association. A current membership card must be produced as in the preceding paragraph.

Rule 9. (e)

Visiting Members of another Yacht Club which is Affiliated to the Royal Yachting Association shall be entitled to use the facilities of the Club.

Rule 9. (f)

Having attained the age of 18 years or 25 years as the case may be under rule 9 (b), children of existing Members may be admitted to a new class of Membership with no voting rights, namely, 'Crew Member' (7).

Rule 9. (g)

Senior Social (6) non boating Members aged 65 and over, Ladies over 60.

Rule 10. (a)

Subscriptions are due and payable on 1st January in each year for the ensuing 12 calendar months; any Member elected after 1st September shall not be liable for a second subscription until the end of the following year.

Rule 10. (b) On election of a new Member, the Hon. Secretary shall notify the same to them and request them to remit the amount of their entrance fee and their subscription. No newly elected Member shall enjoy any privileges of the Club, moor a boat on Club waters, or be allowed to vote, until the entrance fee and subscription have been paid and, in the case of boat owners, mooring fee have been paid in full.

Senior Social Membership: Non boat owning individual membership for Ladies over 60 and Gentlemen over 65.

Associate Membership: A member of at least three years standing of a recognised Yacht Club and who does not moor in Club waters. (i.e. downstream of Lincombe lock and upstream of Tewkesbury Lock)

Crew Membership: Sons or daughters of Family Senior or Family Social Members who have exceeded the age of 18 or 25 if in full time education.
